Dear Ms. Pearl:

I am in receipt of your formal appeal to the City Council regarding the denial of a work card. This matter will be heard by the City Council at their regularly scheduled meeting of **May 3, 2006**.

Your appeal is scheduled to be heard during the morning session of the meeting, which commences at 9:00 a.m. We would advise that you be in attendance to present your appeal and answer any questions which may arise.

Occasionally, the City Council has been persuaded to grant a work card to an applicant through the intercession of the applicant's prospective employer. Therefore, if you think that your prospective employer would acknowledge, either in writing or personally before the City Council at your hearing, that he is aware of the reasons your work card was originally denied and wishes to hire you anyway, I urge you to request him to do so.

If a letter is submitted to the Council, it must be from the licensee or principal who must be approved for suitability under Las Vegas Municipal Code Chapter 6.06 (the owner of the business, other principal or key employee) for the establishment in which you are seeking employment. Also, you should bring to the hearing all other materials which may assist you in your appeal.




