THIS AGREEMENT IS TERMINATED UNDER THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS

1. A return from your bank of the debit(ach) for insufficient funds, account closed or any other reason that is not the fault of the City of Las Vegas or the Depository Institution will result in removal for direct payment. At which time a bill will be generated for any sewer service fees owing and the normal billing process will resume including late charges when applicable. A service charge of \$25.00 NSF fee will also be applied.
2. The property has been sold. Removal will automatically occur once we are notified by the Clark County Assessors of transfer of ownership. A new authorization form will be needed if you obtain a new property and wish to continue direct debit (ACH) from your account.
3. A minimum of 30 days notice is required to terminate this agreement.
