3 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT CODE TO REVISE THE  
4 STANDARDS FOR ALLOWING THE SALE OF AUTOMOBILES, TRUCKS AND BOATS BY  
5 MEANS OF A TEMPORARY COMMERCIAL PERMIT, AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER RELATED  
6 MATTERS.

Summary: Amends the Unified Development  
Code to revise the standards for allowing the sale  
of automobiles, trucks and boats by means of a  
temporary commercial permit.

9 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS  
10 FOLLOWS:

11 SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 6289 and the Unified Development Code adopted as Title  
12 19 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, are hereby amended as set forth  
13 in Section 2 this Ordinance. The amendment is deemed to be an amendment to both Ordinance No. 6289  
14 and the Unified Development Code adopted as Title 19.

15 SECTION 2: Title 19, Chapter 16, Section 160, Subsection (C), is hereby amended to  
16 read as follows:

17 **C. Permitted Uses**

18 The following temporary uses may be permitted by means of the issuance of a Temporary Commercial  
19 Permit.

20 1. A Temporary Contractor's Construction Yard in conjunction with an approved development  
21 project; provided, however, that no Temporary Commercial Permit is required if the use is located on the  
22 same site as the approved development and is operated in conformance with all applicable City ordinances  
23 and standards.

24 2. Seasonal Outdoor Sales, but only if such sales are limited to a maximum of thirty days prior to  
25 the specified holiday. No Temporary Commercial Permit is required when the sales operation:

26 a. Takes place on the same site as, and is in conjunction with, the operation of an

1 established commercial business with a valid business license for that site; and

2 b. Conforms with all applicable City ordinances and standards.

3 3. Parking Lot/Sidewalk Sales; provided, however, that such sales:

4 a. Must take place on the same site as, and be in conjunction with, the operation of an  
5 established commercial business with a valid business license for that site;

6 b. Must take place on a paved or concrete area that is located on the same lot or within the  
7 same commercial subdivision as the structure that houses the business;

8 c. Are limited to a duration of seven days each; and

9 d. Occur no more than four times within a calendar year.

10 4. Temporary Outdoor Commercial Events; provided, however, that such events:

11 a. Are limited to a duration of thirty days each; and

12 b. Occur no more than six times within a calendar year.

13 5. The sales of [new automobiles, new trucks, or new boats at a shopping mall of at least 90 acres  
14 in size and located in the C-1 (or a less restrictive) Zoning District.] automobiles, trucks or boats (whether  
15 new or used) at a shopping center use of at least 20 aggregate acres in size. At any one shopping [mall,]  
16 center, no more than four sales events may occur within any twelve-month period, and no [one sales] single  
17 sales event may last more than three days. All display and sales must take place on a paved surface.

18 6. Any other temporary use that is similar to those enumerated in this Subsection (C) and that, in  
19 the opinion of the Director, is compatible with the zoning district and surrounding land uses.

20 SECTION 3: For purposes of Section 2.100(3) of the City Charter, Section 19.16.160 is  
21 deemed to be a subchapter rather than a section.

22 SECTION 4: The Department of Planning is authorized and directed to incorporate into  
23 the Unified Development Code the amendment set forth in Section 2 of this Ordinance.


24 SECTION 5: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or  
25 phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or  
26 ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or

1 effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City  
2 of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph,  
3 sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections,  
4 subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

5 SECTION 6: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or sections, subsections, phrases,  
6 sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983  
7 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.






