Earth Day Every Day Youth Art Contest Winners To Be Announced *Awards Ceremony To Be Held At Town Square Las Vegas April 23*

The winners of the Earth Day Every Day Youth Art and Essay contest are set to be announced on Saturday, April 23, at 3 p.m. at Town Square Las Vegas.

The city of Las Vegas' Keep Las Vegas Beautiful program, in conjunction with the Clark County School District School-Community Partnership Program, Star Nursery and Republic Services of Southern Nevada, is hosting the sixth annual contest for students in elementary, middle and high schools.

The finalists and their teachers will be at the awards ceremony as part of the "sus•tain•a•ble" Earth Day event at Town Square Las Vegas, 6605 Las Vegas Blvd. South. Cash prizes, sponsored by Republic Services of Southern Nevada, will be awarded to the top three winning students of each age group and their teachers. Artwork submitted by both winners and runners up also will be part of a Youth Earth Day art display at the Town Square event and later at City Hall.
