Worker Killed During Construction Accident

Incident Is Under Investigation By OSHA

Las Vegas Fire and Rescue responded to a construction site at Tivoli Village, 302 S. Rampart Blvd at 1:58 p.m. Monday after fire dispatchers received 9-1-1 calls that scaffolding on site had collapsed and a worker was seriously injured.

When firefighters arrived on scene, they found the worker on the ground. He did not survive the fall. Two other workers were able to jump to safety without injury before the scaffold collapse.

The incident is under investigation by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA), which investigates all work place incidents that result in injury or death. All information concerning the circumstances of the accident will be released by that office. The identity of the worker will be released by the Clark County Coroner's Office.
