City Of Las Vegas Launches New Podcast

Podcast Will Highlight Major Community Issues And Share Stories From Notable Las Vegans

In an effort to make the city more open and accessible, the city of Las Vegas Communications team has launched a podcast series called Vegas TMI. A play off the pop culture phrase TMI, meaning too much information, the title stands for timely, memorable and iconic.

“This is an opportunity for us to reach our audience wherever they might be and in a way that’s easy and convenient for them,” said David Riggelman, communications director for the city of Las Vegas. “While we provide a variety of video content through the city’s government access television station and social media channels, this podcast will offer residents a more in-depth discussion on issues that impact their community.”

On the podcast, city leaders and experts in the community will give context and both sides to issues, projects and events that impact the city. A second segment will focus on the people and personalities that make Las Vegas iconic.

The first episode focuses on the proposed NFL stadium. Brian McAnallan, the city’s government affairs manager, will take us behind what it was like at the Legislature during a historic deal to bring an NFL stadium to Las Vegas and what the political future looks like for the Las Vegas Raiders, should the team move from Oakland. We’ll also talk with Ray Brewer, the assistant managing editor for digital and sports from the Las Vegas Sun. In the second segment, we talk with two devout UNLV football fans about how they think a new stadium and pro team could change UNLV’s football program.

New episodes will be available by the second and fourth Thursdays of the month at lasvegasnevada.gov/podcast. David Riggelman, communications director for the city of Las Vegas, will host the first segment of the show that will focus on a community issue. The second segment will feature notable Las Vegans out in the community and be hosted by various members of the social media team and KCLV Channel 2 producers.
