- Crime Prevention Specialists: Kathy Perkins (k2482p@LVMPD.com) or 828-4305, and, Steve Fuquay (s7495f@LVMPD.com) or 828-7316, are responsible for crime prevention assistance.
- **Neighborhood Watch Informational meetings** are held on rotating Mondays. This meeting is the first step to getting a group started and may be attended by anyone interested in starting a Neighborhood Watch group on their street. Call Crime Prevention for meeting dates/times.
- **First Tuesday Open House**
This is a community presentation program on the first Tuesday of most months at 7 PM at the Area Command. It includes a community interest program, Q & A, and, opportunity to meet area police officers. It is held on the first Tuesday of most months.
- **Apartment crime prevention** to include Crime Free Multi-Housing program, monthly property manager coalition meeting, and free property security inspections. Call 828-7316 for information.
- Free home and business **safety/security reviews**. Done at your home or business and usually takes less than one hour depending upon circumstances.
- Limited meeting **presentations** for your group on crime prevention and safety. Call to discuss specifics.
- Free **crime prevention literature** is available in the front lobby of substation; Vehicle CP, Personal CP, Property CP, ID Theft CP, Home Invasion CP, Vacant Home CP, etc. Other topics are also available. Supplied by limited quantities on request.
