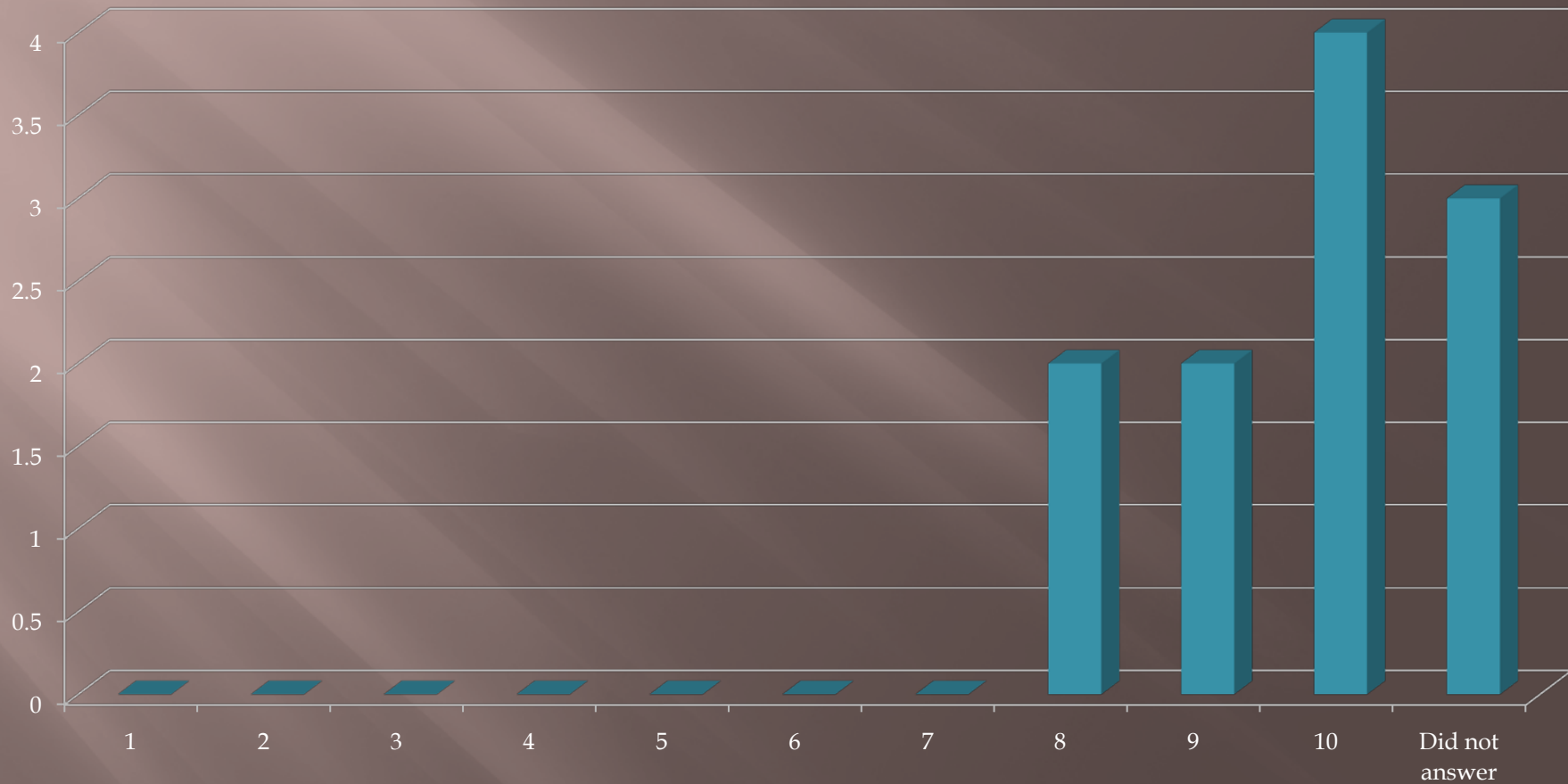

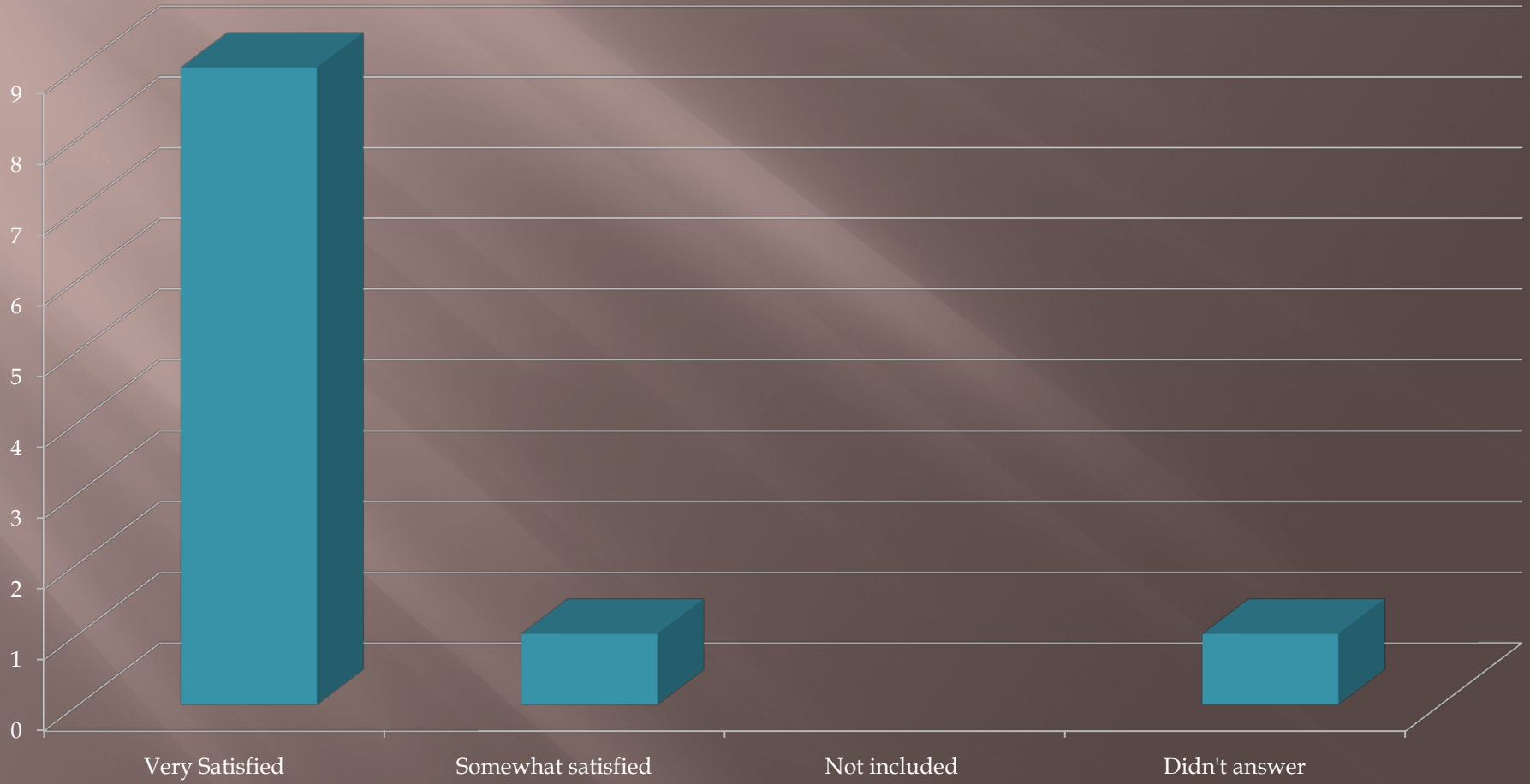
On a scale from 1 to 10, with 10 being the highest, please rate the design workshop process

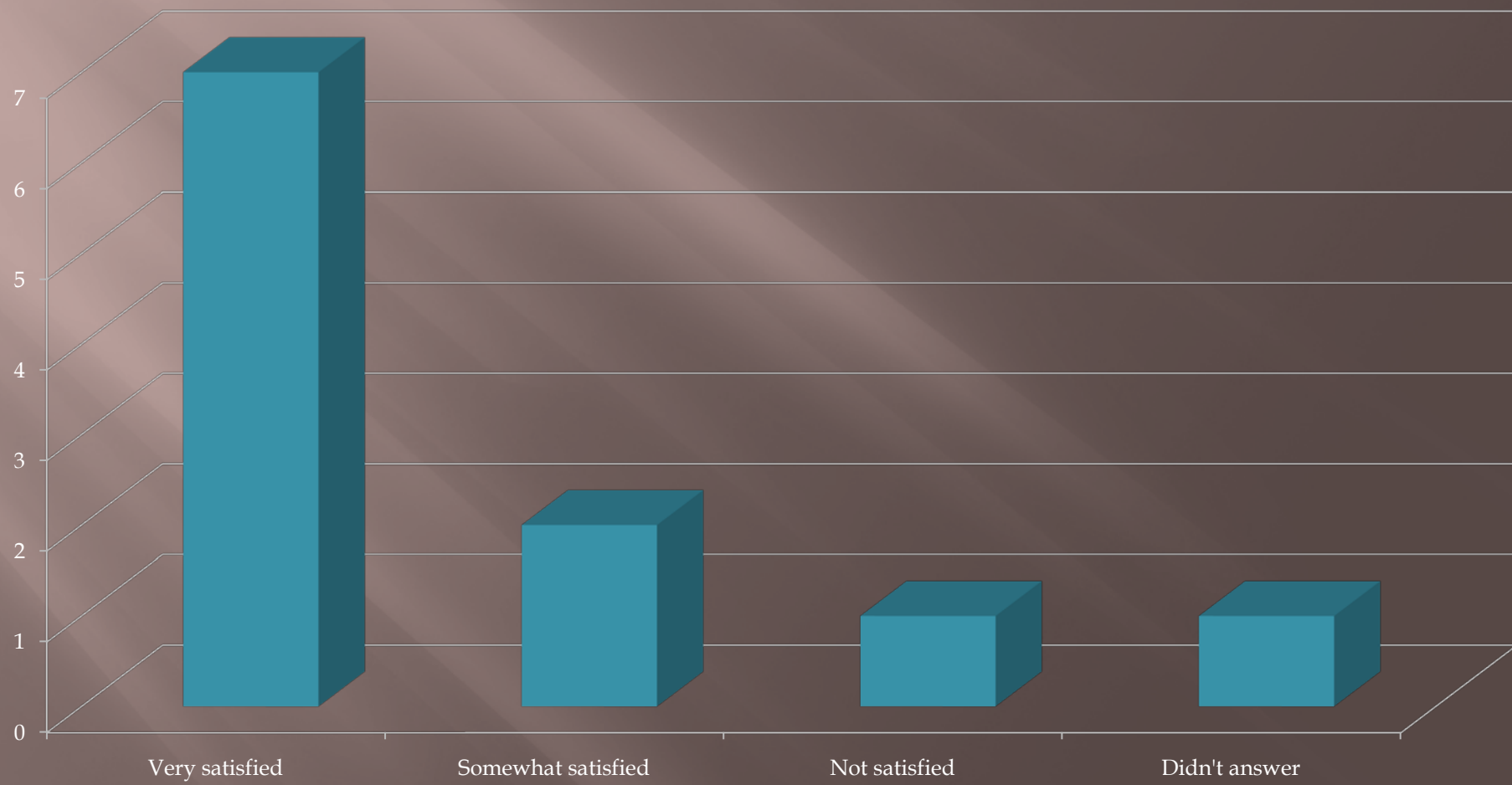
Did you feel included in the workshop process?
