INFANT AND TODDLER DIRECTOR (13.3):

The director of a nursery for infants and toddlers in any facility must:

- a.** Have completed the training required to become a professional nurse;
- b.** Have completed the training required to become a licensed practical nurse, and have at least 6 months of verifiable experience which is satisfactory to the Board in a program related to the care of children under 3 years of age;
- c.** Hold a current credential as a “Child Development Associate for Infants and Toddlers” issued by the Council for Early Childhood Professional Recognition, Washington, DC 20005;
- d.** Be at least 21 years of age and hold a high school diploma or, if approved by the Board, its equivalent, and have completed at least 12 semester hours of education, of which:
 - (1) At least six semester hours are in infant and toddler development; and
 - (2) At least six semester hours are in child development, education related to the health of children or courses directly related to these fields, and at least 2 years of verifiable experience which is satisfactory to the Board in a program related to the care of children under 3 years of age;
or
- e.** Have a combination of education and experience which, in the judgment of the Board, is equivalent to one of the requirements described in paragraphs (a) to (d), inclusive.
